## About Jason Evert

Twenty-nine-year-old Jason Evert earned a master's degree in Theology, and undergraduate degrees in Counseling and Theology, with a minor in Philosophy at Franciscan University of Steubenville. He is the author of the books *If You Really Loved Me*, *Answering Jehovah's Witnesses*, *Love, Sex, and Babies*, and *Pure Love*, which challenges young people to embrace the virtue of chastity. Jason speaks at seminars, participates in debates, and responds to thousands of questions about Catholicism from people around the world.

After giving chastity presentations solo for three years, Jason teamed up with Crystalina Padilla (24), who was trained as a chastity speaker by the Challenge Task Force on Chastity. They speak to over 100,000 teens each year in Catholic, Christian, and public high schools around the country. Both Jason and Crystalina are full-time apologists with Catholic Answers, the nation's largest lay-run apostolate for apologetics and evangelization.

Together, Jason and Crystalina are on the Board of Advisors for the National Abstinence Clearinghouse, and are frequent guests on radio programs throughout the country. Their television appearances include Donauhe, BBC, WGN, and EWTN. And Jason and Crystalina were given the 2003 Impact Award from the National Abstinence Clearinghouse in recognition of their success in working with teens.

### From the North:

1. Take US-15 South towards Frederick.
2. Just north of Frederick, you will see a Citgo station on the right. As you pass the Citgo, get into the right lane.
3. Turn right onto Willow Road, just before Beckley's Motel.
4. Follow Willow to stop sign at T Intersection. Turn left onto Willowbrook RD.
5. Follow Willowbrook to stop sign. Continue straight onto Oppossumtown Pike.
6. Take right into driveway for St. John Regional Catholic School/St. Katharine Pastoral Center.
7. Entrance to Pastoral Center is on the other side of the Circle.

### From the South:

1. Take US-15 North through Frederick, to the City Limits. Get into the left lane as you see Beckley Motel on the left.
2. Turn left onto Willow Road.
3. Follow directions from #4 above.
